DSLR PHOTOGRAPHY:GET OUT OF 'AUTO' MODE · Grades 6-8 Renee Cameron

Do you want to get out of "auto mode," take an intro photo course or learn the features of your DSLR camera to take more interesting photos? This course will introduce you to the mechanics of a digital SLR camera and photographic technique including aperture, shutter speeds, depth of field, white balance, exposure and the various types of digital files. Each student will work to achieve a greater understanding of their camera by learning what these terms mean, what they look like and how certain settings affect an image. In addition, we'll have interesting weekly assignments related to techniques discussed in class. Each student should have a DSLR camera and at least one lens (preferably 35 or 50 mm).
